STATIONS OF THE CROSS

We will have Stations of the Cross inside the church at 6:30 PM every Friday of Lent followed by Mass at 7:00 PM.

The Stations of the Cross, also known as the Way of the Cross or Via Crucis, commemorate Jesus’s passion and death on the cross. There are 14 stations that each depict a moment on his journey to Calvary, usually through sacred art, prayers, and reflections. The practice began as pious pilgrims traced his path through Jerusalem on the Via Dolorosa.

Later, for the many who wanted to pass along the same route, but could not make the trip to Jerusalem, a practice developed that eventually took the form of the fourteen stations currently found in almost every church throughout the world. Similarly, the 150 Hail Marys that were recited for the rosary were an adaptation of the medieval monastic practice of reciting the 150 psalms in the Psalter.

LENTEN FISH FRY

Starting Friday, February 16th until March 22nd the Knights of Columbus will be hosting a Fish Fry in the Parish Hall every Friday in Lent. Dinner will be served at 5:00 PM and after the 7:00 PM Mass. They will be alternating between a fish plate (fried fish fillets, French fries, coleslaw and dinner roll) and fish tacos (fried fish fillet tacos, coleslaw and rice and beans). Prices are to be determined. Debit and credit cards are now accepted.

Every Friday in Lent is a day of ABSTINENCE

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Friday’s in Lent by all Catholics 14 years or older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 60. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one’s own needs, but eating solid foods before meals is not permitted.
