ASH WEDNESDAY – February 18th
Not a Holy Day of Obligation. Our Ash Wednesday Schedule is as follows: 6:30 AM and 8:00 AM Novus Ordo. The Latin Mass will be held at 7:00 PM. Ashes will only be given out after the Masses.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS
We will have Stations of the Cross inside of the church at 6:00 PM every Friday of Lent followed by Mass at 7:00 PM.

LENTEN MEATLESS FRIDAY DINNER
Starting Friday, February 20th we will be hosting a meatless dinner in the Parish Hall every Friday in Lent. Dinner will be served at 5:00 PM and after the 7:00 PM Mass. Plate price will be determined by market price. All proceeds will go towards our 100th Anniversary Guasti Fall Festival fund!

Every Friday in Lent is a day of ABSTINENCE
Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday and all the Friday's in Lent by all Catholics 14 years or older.
Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 60. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's own needs, but eating solid foods before meals is not permitted.

EUCCHARISTIC MONTHLY ADORATION – March 6th – 7th
We will be having our Eucharistic Monthly Adoration inside of the church from Thursday, March 6th at 9:00 AM until Friday, March 7th at 6:00 AM. The sign-up sheet for adoration will be in the back of the church. Won’t you consider spending one hour with our Lord, adoring Him and thanking Him for the many blessings we have received or gifts He has bestowed upon us.
